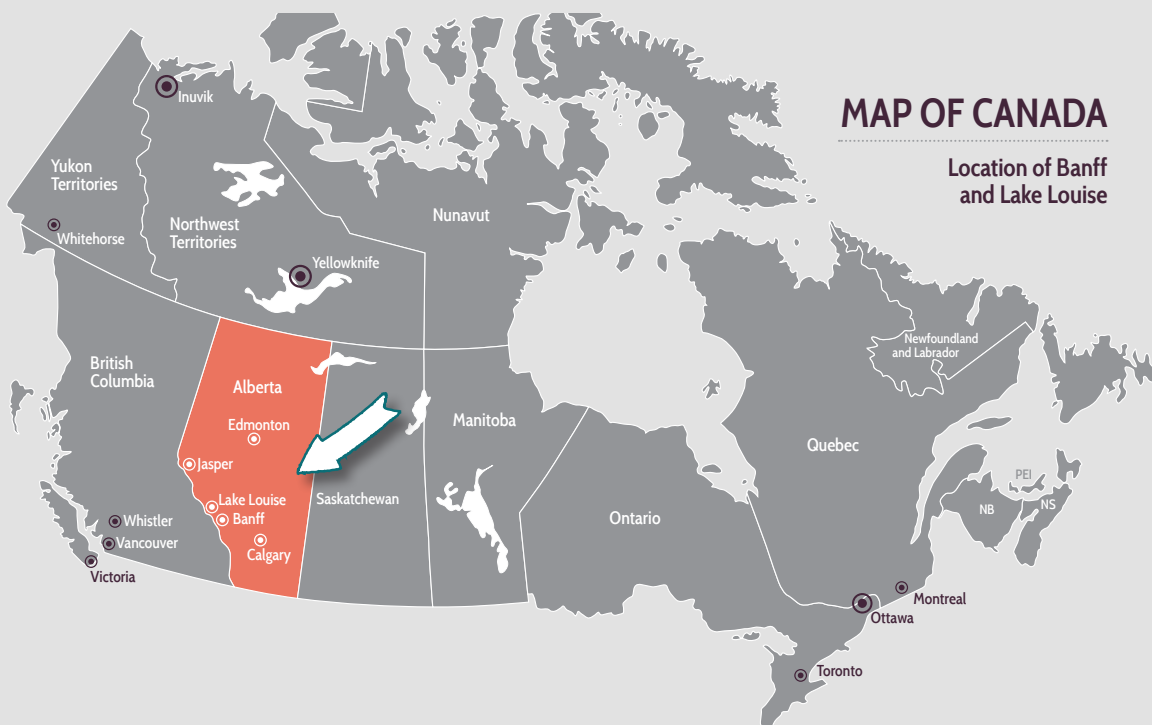

GETTING HERE & GETTING AROUND

Calgary Airport to Banff

(TRANSFER - 90 minutes)

- Brewster Express
- Banff Airporter

Around Banff Township

- Roam bus public transit
- Taxi (no Uber) in Banff only not Lake Louise

Banff to Lake Louise

(45 minutes)

- Brewster Express is the only transportation company that will take passengers and luggage between Banff and Lake Louise for non self-drivers.

Lake Louise Township

- There are no taxis or shuttle bus systems in Lake Louise in winter other than the SkiBig3 shuttles that pick up from hotels to the ski areas, only if you hold a SkiBig3 lift ticket.
- Guests at the Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise, have additional access to a private complimentary shuttle for accessing Lake Louise Ski Resort's winter activities including skiing, boarding, snowshoeing, gondola sightseeing and the day lodge restaurants.
- Lake Louise activities are predominantly centred around where you stay and what's accessible from your hotel within walking distance or what your hotel offers in terms of activities on site.

- Only one tour company offers a transfer with an experience from Lake Louise. Radventures offers a small group tour along the Icefields Parkway to experience Abraham Lake to see the Ice Bubbles, and will pick up from Lake Louise hotels. All other tours to winter activities in Banff National Park (other than ski) depart from Banff township, not Lake Louise.
- In the summer months, Moraine Lake Bus Company offers transfers to Lake Louise and Moraine Lake from Samson Mall or the Lake Louise Summer Gondola. While Fairview Limousine and Shuttle Service pick up guests in the summer months from the Lake Louise Inn.

Ski Buses (SkiBig3)

- In winter only SkiBig3 operate a shuttle service to connect to the three ski areas in Banff National Park including Banff Mt. Norquay, Banff Sunshine and Lake Louise Ski Resort, complimentary with a SkiBig3 lift ticket, Ikon pass or Mountain Collective pass.
- The SkiBig3 shuttles take skis/boards only, not luggage.
- The shuttles operate regularly throughout the day in winter to each of the ski areas and have multiple pick up stops from hotels in both Banff and Lake Louise.

Banff & Lake Louise to Jasper National Park

(3 hours)

- Sundog Tours partner with Brewster Express to operate seasonal transfers connecting Banff and Lake Louise with Jasper National Park for visitors who want to explore further and also Ski Marmot Basin in Jasper or explore Jasper National Park.

Self Drive + National Park Passes

- Self drivers must purchase a National Parks pass either at the park gate entry or on-line at www.banfflakelouise.com/park-pass-purchase
- Self drive is only recommended in winter for confident experience drivers in snowy conditions.
- Winter driving in Banff can be unpredictable, expect snowy and icy conditions. Snow tyres are required on the Ice fields Parkway if driving onto Jasper and recommended for all other roads.
- Car hire companies from the airport gateway of Calgary include: Alamo, Avis, Budget, Hertz, National

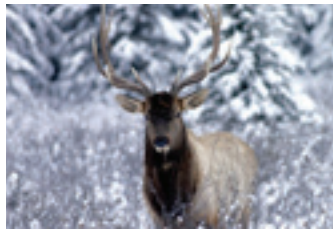

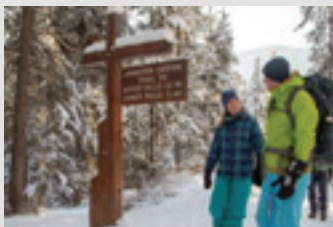

SkiBig3 is the tri-area lift pass for Banff National Park's 3 ski areas

- Mount Norquay
- Banff Sunshine
- The Lake Louise Ski Resort

- Choice of any of the three ski areas to ski/ride
- Shuttles from various stops in Banff and Lake Louise daily to the ski areas in winter only
- Shuttles carry your ski gear under the bus

GETTING TO & AROUND JASPER NATIONAL PARK

INTERNATIONAL AIRPORTS

The Calgary International Airport (YYC) is approximately five hours from Jasper.

The Edmonton International Airport (YEG) is approximately four hours from Jasper.

AIRPORT TRANSFER

Sundog Tours offers daily service between Jasper and Edmonton Airport.

CONNECTING JASPER AND BANFF NATIONAL PARK

Brewster Express offers daily service between Jasper and Lake Louise, Banff and Calgary from May to October. Sundog Tours offers year-round service.

BY RAIL

VIA Rail Canada runs year-round to and from Vancouver and Toronto.

Rocky Mountaineer runs seasonally from mid-April to mid-October to and from Vancouver.

ICEFIELDS PARKWAY

The Icefields Parkway, also known as Highway 93, is an epic stretch of road connecting Jasper and Banff National Parks, and Southern Alberta. National Geographic called it the "drive of a lifetime." Sundog Tours offers year-round service. Drivers should only consider this road in winter months if experienced in snowy conditions.

CAR HIRE

Budget, Avis, and National have offices in Jasper, Calgary & Edmonton International Airports.

SELF-DRIVE TO JASPER

You must purchase a Park Pass if driving to Jasper National Park.

- Edmonton | 366 km/227 mi - 4 hrs
- Calgary | 412 km/255 mi - 5 hrs
- Lake Louise | 233 km/145 mi - 3 hrs
- Banff | 287 km/178 mi - 4 hrs
- Vancouver | 805 km/499 mi - 10 hrs

TAXI

There are multiple Taxi operators in Jasper. UBER does not operate within Jasper National Park.
